Number of events for which a pupil may be entered:

Seniors up to 3 track and 2 field events (plus the relay), or 2 track and 3 field events (plus the relay).

Inters up to 2 track and 2 field events (plus the relay).

Juniors up to 2 track and 1 field events (plus the relay), or 1 track and 2 field events (plus the relay).

Track and Field events will start at 10am promptly.

All pupils in Form 1 - 6 are expected to attend and represent their House on the day and may leave after the presentations at the end of the day at about 4.30p.m.

- Pupils should arrive dressed in CLEAN washed white polo top and socks, navy shorts, trainers/spikes (optional) and tracksuit if necessary
- Pupils should arrive on the games field from 9.30am to collect their house colours from the Information Desk.
- Due to the safety of all athletes, no balls allowed on the games field.
- Track events take priority over field events
- Parents may park on the games field. Please keep to the right of the field as you drive in
- No dogs please we know this is disappointing, but dog faeces and children doing sport are not compatible

Please do bring a picnic lunch along. You are welcome to bring a BBQ, but not the disposable type please. We will also have Craft & Crust with us selling delicious pizzas, and tea and coffee.

Covid-19
