Acrylic pouring is a great fun way of creating a stunning abstract canvas painting. Anyone can do this; no artistic skills are required.

Acrylic pouring is a painting technique where acrylic paint is mixed with some type of pouring medium and then poured onto a surface in a variety of ways. Sometimes colours are poured directly from individual cups, and other times multiple colours are combined into one cup and poured together.

After that, the surface is tilted in each direction to let the paint flow, and the colours interact in unpredictable, yet always interesting ways. Heat can be applied in the form of a hairdryer to create cells as the various colours emerge.

Once the canvas is covered with paint it is left to continue to develop and dry. This can take up to a week. The canvases can then be collected and taken home.

Be aware that this has the potential to be extremely messy, please wear old clothes.
