Flexi-Day Pupils

The Flexi-Day fee covers the period from 8.15 a.m. to 3.00 p.m. It includes the full academic timetable.

For children in Years 3 and 4 it also includes sport every day and timetabled allocation of music, art and swimming.

In addition, there is no charge for Flexi-Day pupils representing the School in sports matches, concerts or attending school events which occur after 3.00pm.

The Activities Programme

The optional afternoon activities programme runs from 3.00 p.m. to 6.00 p.m.

There are three activity sessions:

3.00 p.m. – 4.00 p.m.

4.00 p.m. – 5.00 p.m.

5.00 p.m. – 6.00 p.m.

Each session costs £28.50*. Flexi-Day pupils can choose from the following activities to create a personal timetable. Taster sessions are available.

Sports sessions for Years 5 to 8 are generally timetabled in the first session from 3.00 p.m. to 4.00 p.m.

Activities require a commitment of a term. Notice period: In the Autumn Term we require half a term's notice and then, beyond that, a full term's notice.

Parents are free to collect children at 3.00 p.m., 4.00 p.m., 5.00 p.m. and from 5.50 p.m.
