On Monday 19th February Form 1 Leavers have the unique and wonderful opportunity to visit the Houses of Parliament for a tour inside the chambers. I have also arranged a meeting and question time with a current MP.

We will be leaving school at 7:30am on a hired coach. If not boarding please ensure you arrive by 7:20am. We are booked into Parliament first where we will take our tour. Following this we will have the time to visit the National History Museum before returning to school. We should be back at school at about 5.50pm. I have planned the trip to give us plenty of time to get back to school but if we are affected by the London traffic and will be late I will send an email out as soon as I know.

The cost of the trip will be approximately £48 which will be added to your end of term bill.

I would like the pupils to wear full school uniform with blazers. Please do NOT send a backpack or similar bags as these are NOT allowed through the airport style security that we will go through to get into the Houses of Parliament. Children may bring a disposable water bottle for the journey that must be thrown out before entering Parliament and I will purchase food and water for the rest of the day.

Children may bring mobile phones and like the French Trip I will have strict rules about the use of these. There is a gift shop at Parliament and the museum so the children may bring a small amount of money.

I will lead the trip with other staff accompanying us. If you would like your child to board on the Sunday night please request this in the normal way as beds will be limited.
